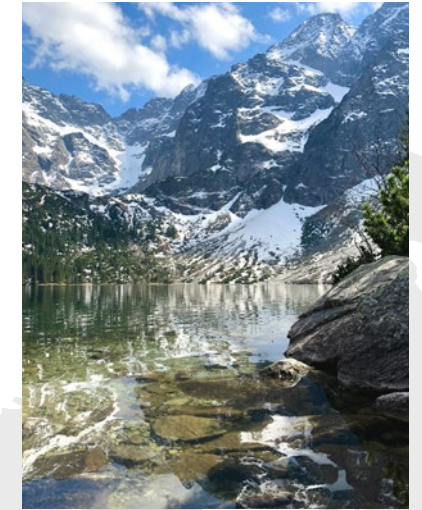
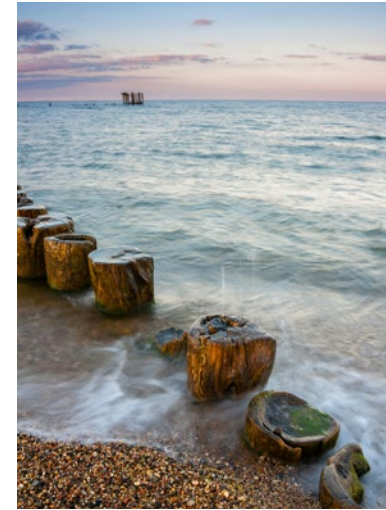

Lublin is the largest Polish city east of the Vistula River and located approximately 170 kilometers (106 miles) to the southeast of Warsaw by road or train. It is the City of Inspiration for young and active people with its 65,000-strong student community, including over 8000 foreign students.

Lublin’s 700-year-long history abounds in events that changed Poland and Europe. Its historical heritage, its Renaissance tradition, and its mosaic of nations, cultures and religions have all contributed to the unique atmosphere that continues to pervade the city.

Nursing programme is aimed at candidates who are prepared to provide direct health care services in hospitals, outpatient clinics, medical or penal institutions, residential homes and many others. The main goal of the Nursing programme is to gain the necessary knowledge and skills from experienced staff and to prepare students for work in a profession which has an ever-increasing demand and social prestige.

Our 3-year BSc Nursing programme enables the student to obtain professional qualifications in accordance

with European Union requirements in medical sciences and nursing practice.

The curriculum is based on strict standards and includes theoretical and practical aspects of nursing as well as general-development humanistic knowledge. During the programme the student will acquire the knowledge of basic medical subjects, such as: anatomy, biochemistry, physiology, pathology etc.; social sciences, for instance: sociology, law, pedagogy, etc. as well as General and Specialized nursing subjects.



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Upon graduation from Nursing programme, students can apply for a license and in turn practice nursing independently all over the world.

# Nursing

 2 years (4 semesters)

Second-cycle studies in the field of Nursing at our university is a way to meet the needs of the future population, or more precisely, the demographic forecasts, according to which 1/6 the total population of the whole world is made out of people over 60 years of age, in need of highly specialized personnel providing care. Nursing is one of the professions of public trust. It is a field of study created for people who want to help others, and well-qualified nurses are in constant demand.

During Nursing master's degree program, students expand the knowledge and skills acquired during their undergraduate studies, mainly in specialized nursing, management in nursing care, medical didactics and research methodology.

A graduate of a master's degree program has the ability to use advanced knowledge in the field of medical science and nursing as well as the ability to cooperate with team members in improving the quality of care.



In addition, Nursing studies have a practical profile, and emphasis is placed not only on training in medicine, but also on the philosophy and ethics of the nursing profession, as well as psychology and sociology.

An important area of nursing activity is health-promoting prevention. Hence, an important part of the educational program is health promotion – education in health maintenance and disease prevention.

# Midwifery

Midwifery is one of the oldest branches of medicine. The programme allows the students to acquire specialist knowledge from the area of medical science, specifically prenatal medicine, neonatology, gynaecology and nursing. What is more, they also learn about all medical treatments meant for pregnant women, women in labour and newborn children.

Midwifery is a socially responsible profession which, apart from knowledge, requires dedication, passion and vocation. Potential candidates should be responsible,

reliable, conscientious, friendly and able to make decisions. They should also respect other people's dignity, care about others and be ready to constantly improve their knowledge and skills.

Around the world, there is a great demand for qualified medical staff. As a result, Midwifery graduates need not worry about future employment as they are welcomed not only on the national but also international job market. The curriculum allows the students to gain specialist knowledge and skills, which open numerous career



opportunities, including further education in the field. A certified midwife is also a health educator, able to pass on the knowledge about family planning, monitoring of pregnancy and successful child delivery. Apart from the specialist subject, students also learn Polish language, which allows them to function both in the country and abroad. Successful graduates obtain the Bachelor's diploma, which is recognized in all European Union countries.

# VPU Medical Simulation Centre

The Medical Simulation Centre of Vincent Pol University was opened on the 8th of November, 2021. It was co-financed by the Ministry of Health as a part of the project "Innovative Education for Nursing Students – Creation of a Single-profile Medical Simulation Centre at Vincent Pol University in Lublin".

The aim of the project was to improve the quality of education not only for nursing, but also other medical programmes taught at the university. As an element of the project, a development plan was prepared, the main aspect of which was the creation of the Centre. VPU students can already use the new facilities and have access to state-of-the-art educational solutions offered. Classes taught using the medical simulation methods enable students to significantly increase their competences, which, in turn, enhances their professional opportunities.

Medical simulation is the best way to develop practical skills. Students are able to perform certain activities and procedures in standardized, controlled and recurrent conditions. They can also receive immediate feedback from experienced and well-qualified teachers. The ability to practice advanced scenarios in the first stage of education results in more fruitful participation in practical classes, which ultimately leads to greater safety of patients and higher quality of professional conduct.

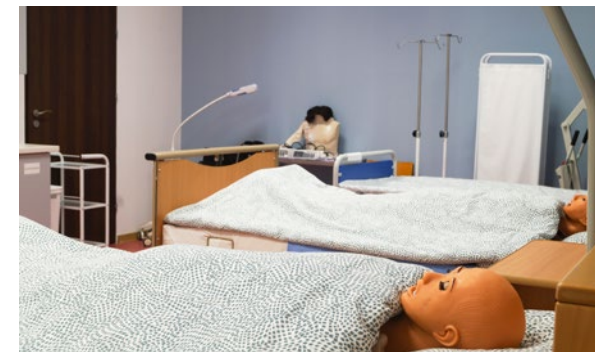

**Physiotherapy is a medical profession providing healthcare services with respect to restoring and maintaining proper body functionality and mobility. In many settings, physical therapy is combined with other medical services, aimed at prevention and treatment of illnesses.**

Our 5-year MSc Physiotherapy programme has been developed with full reference to recent changes in health service provisions in EU and within education standards and directives of the World Confederation for Physical

Therapy (WCPT). The future physiotherapists are taught by experienced health care professionals who are committed to ensuring that students will develop the knowledge, knowledge, skills, attitudes and values which they will then use to identify patient problems, set treatment goals, select and safely apply appropriate evidencebased physiotherapy treatment so that patients reach their maximum potential. Our Physiotherapy programme provides an innovative, student-centered and employability-focused curriculum. Students gain the knowledge of the most up-to-date forms of manual therapy (Kinesiotaping),



neurodevelopmental techniques (PNF, NDT-Bobath), physical medicine, functional diagnosis and rehabilitation programming. Graduates are prepared for work in scientific research institutions, and are eligible to apply for a professional specialty in physiotherapy as well as PhD studies.

The main aim of Beauty Science studies is to educate highly qualified, creative and socially responsible beauty therapists prepared for the professional career, seeking personal and professional growth through lifelong learning.**

Our 3-year BSc Beauty Science programme includes lectures and classes taught in professional, well equipped cosmetology labs, by experienced, highly qu-

alified and dedicated academic staff, professionals such as dermatologists, allergists or plastic surgeons.

The future beauty therapists will be able to develop tools and techniques to maintain a healthy facial and body skin, eliminate skin and body defects, highlight attractive features of the face and shape the desired image, by employing the latest technologies in cosmetic procedures.

In response to evolving demands of the job market, our Beauty Science programme involves not only medical co-



urses like anatomy, physiology or genetics and biology but also unique classes, such as thalassotherapy, podology or perfumery and a wide range of optional certified workshops. Students are also provided with scientific development opportunities thanks to participation in symposiums and conferences organized by the University.

# Beauty Science

 2 years (4 semesters)

 120 ECTS

 Master of Science

 English

The main concept of education during the second cycle programme in Beauty Science at Vincent Pol University is to educate qualified specialists, who will have in-depth and practical knowledge in the field of broadly understood cosmetology, which will enable them to perform advanced cosmetic procedures, select appropriate cosmetic products, and indicate their application on the basis of pharmacological knowledge.

The study program consists of theoretical foundations, including a number of subjects from scientific disciplines such as health sciences, medical sciences and pharmaceutical sciences, and practical subjects.

The educational plan includes medical subjects such as: anatomy with particular emphasis on the head, neck and lower limb, skin oncology, endocrinology, elements of allergology, pharmacology or trichology.



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They will allow students to acquire and deepen knowledge of the structure and functioning of the human body in health or illness, being a good basis for conducting specialized cosmetic procedures. The program, however, is focused on the improvement and deepening of practical skills by the student, which will allow to perfect the skills of diagnosing the condition of the skin, distinguish skin defects, plan and carry out cosmetic procedures, including advanced therapies with the use of modern cosmetological equipment and properly selected cosmetics. The program will include, among others, classes in aesthetic and anti-aging cosmetology, trichology, orthopodology and beauty and beautifying cosmetology laboratory.

# Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics

 3 years (6 semesters)

The idea of education in the field of dietetics first-cycle studies is based on the assumption that a dietitian is a health care professional with knowledge of the nutritional determinants of human health and diseases.

Graduates of the dietetics bachelor's degree program, in accordance with the European trend of treating dietetics as a medical profession, will receive preparation in medical and health sciences, taking into account those aspects of knowledge that are necessary in dia-

gnosing the nutritional state and mode of nutrition and planning nutritional management.

The foundation of first-cycle education in health and medical sciences and food and nutrition sciences is common to all students and is the starting point for continuing education in, one of two specializations chosen by students: Clinical Dietetics or Nutrition in Sports and Fitness. By offering a choice of specializations, we are answering the educational needs of those adepts of the dietetics profession who do not feel predisposed to

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work with patients in a medical context, but wish to deal with dietary counseling addressed to healthy people with special nutritional needs related to their lifestyles.

# Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics

The education program of the second degree program is designed as a universal offer to supplement the education in dietetics from the level of bachelor's degree, dedicated also to graduates of first or second-cycle degree programs in other majors related to human nutrition, dietetics or food technology, which leads to the professional title of master's degree.

Graduates of the second degree program will receive a development and deepening of practical medical tra-

ining in human nutrition and dietetics, with particular emphasis on contemporary health risks (primary and secondary prevention of diet-related diseases). They will be prepared to establish and run a business with a profile of human nutrition and dietetics.

The primary goal of training is to prepare a nutritionist – a medical professional, to work in therapeutic and health promotion teams, as well as to undertake management demands in entities involved in various forms of human nutrition.

Tourism and Hospitality Management prepares students for managing various institutions within the hospitality industry and supplying culinary, accommodation and related services to tourists and visitors.**

Our 3-year BA Tourism and Hospitality Management programme combines both academic and practical

aspects of tourism, allowing students to gain first-hand industry experience, to live an unforgettable adventure as well as to learn and appreciate different cultures. An important part of this programme is working with the staff – professionals in the tourism and hospitality industries, as well as participating in guest lectures at the University and study visits to partner hotels, tourist sites and entertainment venues.

Students have the opportunity to choose one of two specialities: Hospitality Management or Tourism Management,

This allows students to specialise in their chosen areas of interest.

Our 2-year MA International Tourism programme enables the students to choose one of two interesting specializations: Tourism and Hospitality Management

Students also develop academic, decision making and critical evaluation skills. Apart from theoretical issues, there is also a practical focus on the managerial and strategic issues in tourism, which belongs to the most rapidly developing branches in the world economy.

Studying the second degree in International Business Management allows you to obtain a comprehensive and expanded knowledge of economics and the ability to manage financial, human and material resources. The knowledge imparted during the course of study allows you to learn the principles of advanced analytical methods to study economic phenomena.

Graduates are able to work in diverse conditions of the international market environment and in multicultural teams, as they have the skills to cooperate in a team or lead teams. Graduates are familiar with models of

economic growth and development, including sustainable development, as well as with the mechanisms of the modern world economy and national economies open to international flows. Master's studies of the second degree also provide the basis for further education in postgraduate and doctoral studies (of the third degree), enable to undertake scientific and/or educational work.

**The IBM programme** is a response to the growing demand for employees who are familiar with the functioning of businesses and institutions in the conditions of internationalization (including European integration)



and who are able to operate while cooperating and competing with domestic and foreign partners. International Business Management is a specialization designed for those who wish to actively operate in international markets and seek practical skills and knowledge in this area. The purpose of the specialization is to enable students to gain comprehensive knowledge of international business and acquire practical skills for conducting activities in various forms of business activity on the open domestic and international markets, including their own business. In this specialization we will prepare you to work in multinational corporations, companies cooperating in international markets or offices cooperating with foreign countries.

If you are thinking about studying abroad, but you are not sure if your language skills are sufficient, or you do not have the required language certificate, you should consider signing up for the English Language Preparatory Course. VPU offers a course, which is perfect preparation for non-native English speaking students who wish to study a degree at the university, or who are serious about improving their level of English.

Open to all students whose first language is not English, the course provides you with comprehensive

general and academic learning in all relevant areas of English language — giving you the opportunity to practice your reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills with your tutor and your fellow students. You will have the opportunity to increase your knowledge of English grammar and vocabulary and develop your academic skills, in order to meet your required level of English.

The course ends with a final exam (level B2). The exam will be recognised as a proof of English language competence required for admissions at VPU.

# Medical Science Centre

**On October 22, 2023, on the occasion of the official inauguration of the 2023/2024 academic year, a state-of-the-art Medical Science Centre was opened at Vincent Pol University.**

The facility is primarily intended for teaching purposes and aimed mainly at physiotherapy, nursing and cosmetology students. The new building is designed with classrooms for exercises and lectures, laboratories such as kinesitherapy, physical therapy, biomechanics, information technology, as well as laboratories, including a large anatomy lab or medical laboratory.

*— These modern offices will not only serve our students, but also improve the comfort of our lecturers, create better conditions for teaching. This is very important for the scientific development of our staff. We want to educate personnel for health care sector here, and at the highest level — explains the University's Rector Mariusz Korczyński, Ph.D., Professor of VPU.*

Academic Medical Science Centre was built next to the University's existing building at 2 Choiny Street; the two buildings are connected and form a common complex. The new building has four floors above ground,

and is one floor higher than the existing edifice. It has more than 4,200 square meters of space. It has been equipped with the most modern medical equipment and has all the facilities needed for education.

*— We are a university that is constantly developing, reaching for modern educational solutions, which is reflected in the Centre we are just launching. We want to prepare the graduates of our University as reliably as possible for professional work — the Rector explained.*

On the ground floor of the Centre you will find, among other things, a bistro bar and beauty salons. *— The offices are used not only for practical classes for students, but also ultimately for commercial treatments. Our students, under the guidance of qualified specialists, will receive external clients here and offer them various cosmetological treatments — stresses the Chancellor, President and Founder of Vincent Pol University, Associate Professor Henryk Stefanek.*

The second floor includes teaching rooms, a rehabilitation room, as well as a library. *— We are very proud of the new rooms for the library and reading rooms. Their area is three times larger than the previous premises. It's more comfortable for students — assures the Chancellor.*

The building also has two amphitheater auditoriums with large screens. They are located on the second and third floors. Among other things, they are used for national or international scientific conferences and many events.

Moreover, the space around the complex has also changed. New parking spaces have been created on the campus, new greenery has been planted, and there are plans to build a full-size multipurpose sports field.

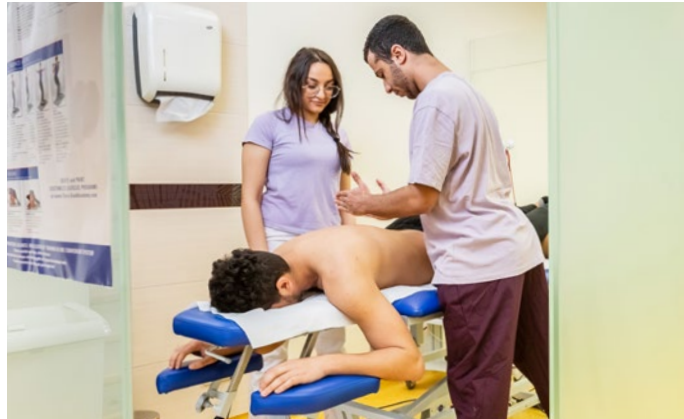
*— The ecological dimension has not been forgotten. The new Centre is heated with heat pumps, we have installed photovoltaics, automatic ventilation, and the halls and corridors are air-conditioned. This is a building for the 21st century — concludes Associate Professor Henryk Stefanek.*





## Academic Physiotherapy Centre

In 2010 VPU founded the Academic Physiotherapy Centre, a modern clinic boasting invaluable experience, which can be used not only by our physiotherapy students but also by the citizens of Lublin. The centre has the most modern equipment for a full body diagnostics and rehabilitation and is contracted with the Polish National Health System. Due to the invaluable experience gained from practical sessions attended by future physiotherapists, it is also a place where students do their clinical practice and where scientific research is conducted.



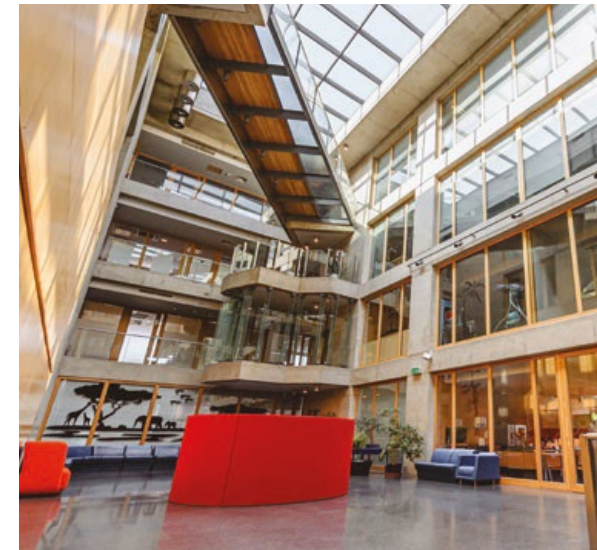
## Chodźki OFFICE

Since 2022, Vincent Pol University is maintaining an ongoing deal to conduct classes and lectures at a modern office space: **Chodźki OFFICE**. Our students can use the classroom and a professional Lecture Hall, fully equipped in specialised electronic equipment.

The building is very well situated in terms of availability, be it by walking, cycling, driving or using city transport. There are a number of bus stops in the vicinity, which allow to travel easily to the city centre and other districts of Lublin. Other locations nearby include: a supermarket, restaurants and a shopping mall.



The location of Chodźki OFFICE is also very close to that of our University Campus – It is merely 600 metres away.





# University library

The library of Vincent Pol University was established in 2000 and until recently was located in the main building of the university. At the end of October 2023 the University opened a modern Medical Science Centre, where the new library and reading room have been relocated. The premises have a modern design – their space is three times larger than the former premises.

The library reading room has computer workstations so that users have constant access to the Internet. Some of the computer workstations are adapted for the visually impaired – magnifying devices, BigKeys keyboard, ZoomText large-print keyboard. The reading room is also adapted to the needs of individual student work.

Students and lecturers of any course will find here books and exercises from their field of study, needed during their studies, as well as from many other areas of their interest.

The systematically enriched and updated book collection, currently numbering around 22,000 volumes, includes items on medical rehabilitation, nursing, midwifery, economics, physiotherapy, cosmetology, tourism and recreation and physical education, as well as dictionaries, encyclopaedias, textbooks, specialist journals and multimedia items.

The latest academic and professional journals are regularly imported. The operation of the VPU Library is sup-

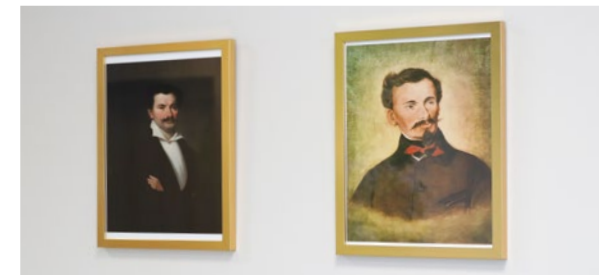
ported by a specialised computer programme MAK+, recommended by the National Library Board. Students can therefore remotely browse the library catalogue, check the availability of individual items, manage their own account and borrow copies.

As an additional convenience, VPU students are given free access to a number of academic databases collecting their resources online. These include: IBUK Libra, Virtual Library of Science – Academica, e-Publications of Polish Science (EPNP). New for medical students is the ClinicalKey database, where full texts of specialist journals and bestselling books, among others, are available.

The library in the new University building is located on the first floor and is open five days a week, Tuesday to Saturday, 8.30 a.m. to 3.30 p.m. It can be used by students, postgraduate students and researchers.

## Explore the world of works of the Univeristy's patron, Vincent Pol

The VPU's collection of memorabilia and editions of the works of the poet and geographer – the university's patron – are presented in a small exhibition in the library's new premises. Attention is drawn to *Dzieła wierszem i prozą. Pierwsze wydanie zbiorowe przejrzane i uporządkowane przez samego autora* (Lviv 1875-1878), with a gilded image of the poet. As far as poetry volumes are concerned, presented are: *Pieśni Janusza* (1863), *Pieśń o ziemi naszej* – “a heartfelt geography



of the Polish lands” – and *Pieśń o ziemi*, the Warsaw edition of 1859, which was cut down by the censorship, *Pieśń o domu naszym* (Lviv 1866), as well as the volume *Poezje Wincentego Pola* (Vienna 1857).

Academic achievements in the field of geography and ethnography – the result of Pol's research journeys – are contained in the volumes *Dzieła prozą – Pisma geograficzne*. These include *Geografia Ziemi Świętej w dwóch tomach* and “Karta Tatrów” made by Pol for didactic purposes. Memories of expeditions written years later, *Obrazy z życia i natury* (Krakow 1869), are illustrated with a map of Rügen (woodcut).

We also include *Wykaz odznaczeń i członkostwa w towarzystwach naukowych W. Pola*, drawn up in 1902 by his son. Between the books you can see the images of the poet, photographs, a correspondent's card with his bust and medals. Above the display cases there are four photographic copies of oil portraits of Pol by: Marcin Jablonski, Franciszek K. J. Daniszewski, Andrzej Grabowski and Mirosława Wójcik (copy according to aqu. Friedrich Lieder junior from Vienna).





# Publishing house

VPU's publishing house was established in 2004. Its main aim is to prepare and print scientific and popular science texts — books, monographies, and journals — that result from our academic staff research enterprises. It also provides a variety of student coursebooks, manuals and provisory notes. The subject matter of publishing house outcome touch upon both local and global issues.

## Academic journals

The Quarterly **Archives of Physiotherapy and Global Researches** is a periodical addressed to scientists, doctors, pharmacologists, chemists, psychologists and physiotherapists involved in the process of treating patients including basic pre-clinical tests, diagnostic tests, clinical tests and rehabilitation of movement, mental health as well as a healthy diet. The quarterly aims at creating a platform where representatives of all the sciences concerned with the treating process are able to exchange their knowledge, experience, achievements and discoveries.

The biannual journal **Archives of Tourism, Hospitality and Sport Science** is an international, scholarly and refereed periodical aiming to promote and further research in the fields of tourism, hospitality, recreation and physical education. The journal is addressed to both members of the scholarly community dealing with tourism, hospitality, recreation and sport science, as well as business practitioners and professionals.



Starting from regional guides, albums and even postcards, through general publications on the national level, finishing with international journals elaborated in cooperation with health scientist all over the globe, VPU publishing house is considered as a truly universal instrument for a vivid academic development.



# Piotrawin

## Education and Recreation Centre in Piotrawin

VPU students have the opportunity to study and rest in the Education and Recreation Centre in Piotrawin. It is located next to the Vistula River, about 60 kilometers from Lublin, and about 15 kilometers from Kazimierz Dolny — in the area of a beautiful landscape park, forest and water recreational environment. 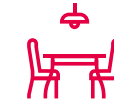

- scanned copies English Certificates
- scanned Passport copy (page with personal data)
- scanned Photo
- scanned Application Form

You can also send all the above scanned documents to [infoenglish@pol.edu.pl](mailto:infoenglish@pol.edu.pl) for verification and initial registration.

## 4. Wait for the final decision about your admission.

If your application meets university's requirements, you will receive a scan of Offer Letter by e-mail. You should check your e-mail regularly. If you accept our offer, and agree to follow the rules of the University, please sign the Acceptance of Offer and send it back together with the confirmation of administration fee payment (this fee is non-refundable) to [infoenglish@pol.edu.pl](mailto:infoenglish@pol.edu.pl). Payment details are included in the Offer letter.

## 5. Choose suitable accommodation

International students may apply for university accommodation in one of PRUSA CENTRE APARTMENTS, which are all located near the city centre. There are single rooms and double shared rooms available. They may also look for private accommodation on their own.

Please inform us about your accommodation preferences, because when you decide to live in a dormitory and sign your Offer Letter, we need to check the room availability and reserve the place.

## 6. Confirmation on your enrolment

After receiving your signed Acceptance of Offer and the confirmation of your payment we will send you the Final Acceptance Letter and the support letter to the Polish Embassy. These documents are necessary to apply for the visa.

## 7. Apply for your visa

It can take several weeks for your visa to be processed so you should make your own arrangements for student visa in good time to start the course promptly.

## 8. Welcome to Vincent Pol University in Lublin, Poland!

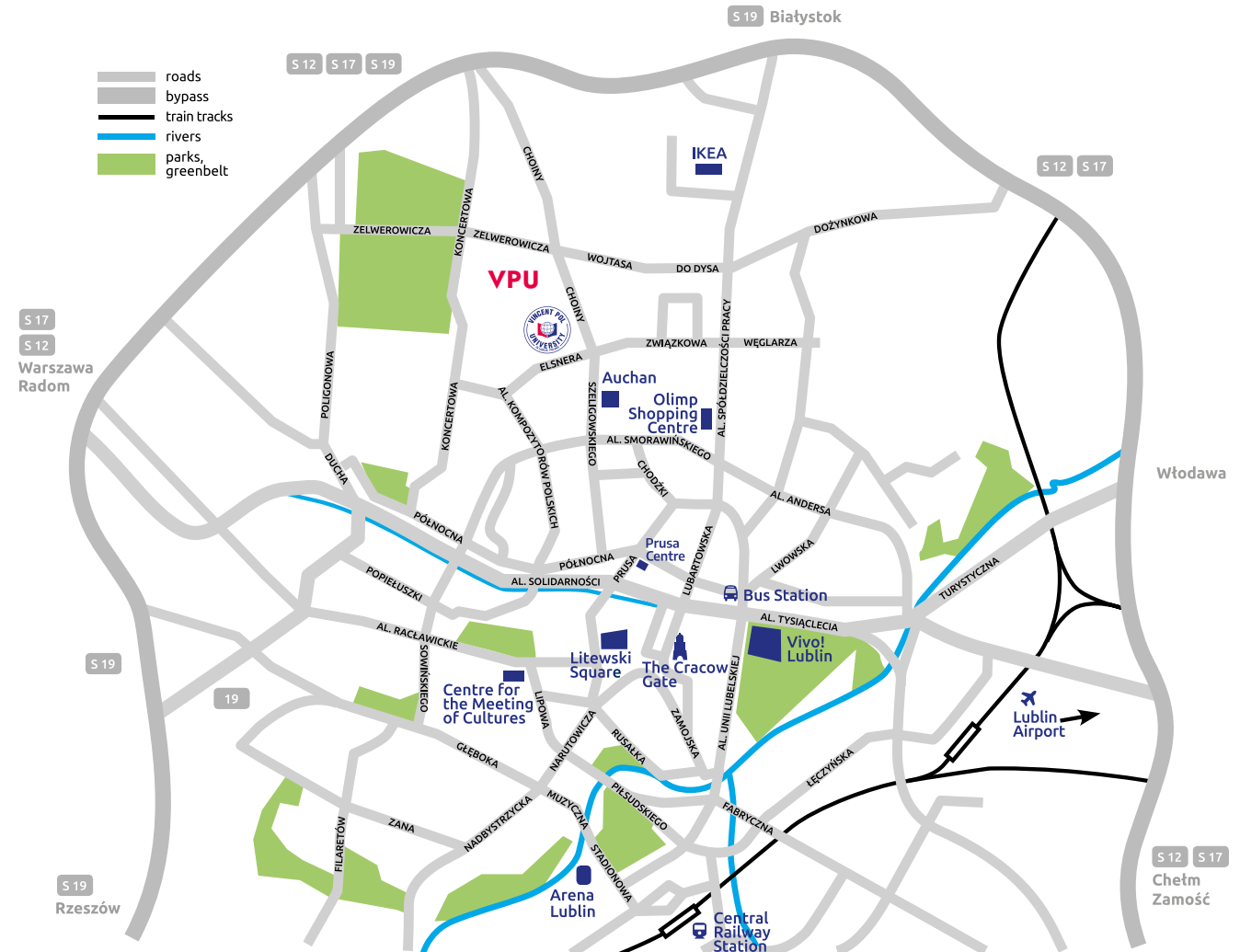


# Required documents

- ❑ **1. Application Form**
- ❑ **2. High School Diploma and High School transcript** original or a copy certified by a notary public, and if applicable, a certified translation to English
- ❑ **3. Eligibility document** issued by a Polish Consulate/Embassy or the Ministry of Education, stating that the holder is entitled to study at the university in the country where the diploma was issued
- ❑ **4. Certificate of Recognition** issued by a local educational authority (Kuratorium Oświaty) having jurisdiction over the applicant's place of residence, or, if the applicant has no such place of residence, the local authorities having jurisdiction over the head office of the institution to which the prospective student applies
- ❑ **5. Certificate of English Language Proficiency** – this requirement does not apply to those applicants for whom English is either a native language or a language of instruction at school
- ❑ **6. Copy of passport** (page with personal data)
- ❑ **7. Medical Health Certificate** completed by a doctor and including a clause that the student is in good health and is capable of commencing studies
- ❑ **8. 4 current photographs** (35mm x 45mm, at least one colour photograph)

**Note:** Apart from the documents listed above, Master degree course applicants have to submit their Bachelor diploma and Academic Transcript (originals or copies certified by a notary public, and, if applicable, a certified translation to English).

All the certificates and diplomas require legalization in the country of their origin. Documents issued in countries which are parties to the Hague Convention (the convention that abolishes the requirement of legalization for foreign public documents), must bear an Apostille.
